- Provide a portal that contains a union catalog of the holdings of the partners, and provide links to these resources
- Digitize resources which are produced locally such as, but not limited to theses and dissertations, scholarly publications in the humanities, social sciences, and science and technology, and materials that represent the country's cultural heritage
- Share subscriptions of online databases and make these available to a wider audience
- Facilitate access to these resources particularly to state universities and colleges (SUCs), and the Filipino citizenry in general

### What are the privileges of pre-paid card users and subscribers?

Individual subscribers can search the union catalog; download Filipiniana full-text materials; subscribe to SDI services; login and access eLib from any Internet connected computer; search and post questions in the FAQ section; and, change password (Individual subscribers only). Prepaid card users have the following privileges: search the union catalog; subscribe to SDI services; download Filipiniana full-text materials; login and access eLib from any Internet connected computer; and, search and post questions in the FAQ section.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Who can access and use Philippine eLib resources?

All members of the partner agencies and their affinity sites can have free and unlimited access of the Philippine eLib resources. Researchers from non-partner institutions may apply for individual subscription with unlimited access or buy pre-paid cards with limited access membership.

### How can I avail of individual subscription/membership?

Researchers may apply for individual subscription/membership with the following rates: Php50 per person/day; Php1,200 per person/month; and, Php7,000 per person/6 months (one-shot payment). They need to fill-up the registration form in the website and pay the subscription fee by check or money order to UP-Philippine eLib Fund Account No. 9699911-499-450 and send it to Mrs. Salvacion Arlante of the UP University Library, Gonzalez Hall, UP Diliman, Quezon City.

### Where can I buy pre-paid cards?

Individuals may use pre-paid cards with cost varying from Php100, Php300, Php500 and Php1,000 per card. The cards may be purchased from the partner institutions or designated outlets such as UP Diliman, National Library of the Philippines, etc. The prepaid cards may be used on or off campus kiosks. All downloaded materials will be assessed chargeable against the prepaid cards account (Php5 per page downloaded).
